No doubt you have not had neither the letters nor the cable-grams which I have sent to Amerika during the war. Now your mother requests me again to write anew to you and to your brother Jose in New York (she gives his address as Broadway 61. So right?). She is living in very painful circumstances. The war has ruined her totally and she and the children are living in greatest need. And to the loss of your Rev. father and the loss of all her goods come the anxious feelings about you and your brother, of whom she knows nothing for so many years. I therefore ask you to let me have good news for your poor mother.
