Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge with many thanks the letters and reports enumerated in your letter of May 10, together with further documents dated May 13, 14, 15, (2) 16, 18, 20, 21, 22, and 23, (2). I have also received several telegrams from you relating to the pogroms, copies of which have been at once communicated to the British Foreign Office, and to the British Delegation at the Peace Conference.

I am much obliged to you for all these communications which have proved very useful to me. With regard to what you say about Mr. Ruwin Blank I am sorry to have ~~xxxxxx~~ to inform you that he has not shown me any of your reports.

You will be pleased to hear that the Cause of our Polish co-religionists is being very effectually promoted in this city and that we hope very shortly to be able to announce to you a decision which will go far to assure a happier life for the Jews of Poland in the future.
