Bernhard G. Richards, Esq. near Sir:-

I had to-day your letter of 7th November. You presume that I have contributed an article on Poland to a Stockholm newspaper, but I think that you have committed a little error. I have never written for Stockholm, and it is a half year since I have written a little article on the Jewish situation in Poland for the Copenhagener paper "Berlingske Tidende". Perhaps you mean an article on the situation in Lithuania, written for the Copenhagener paper "Politiken" (a brief time ago there was created quite another "Bolitiken" in Stockholm, and perhaps the two your error comes from the same name of quite dwfferent papers). I shall be glad to send you a copy of this article.

I thank you for the copy of the circular\_letter on the congress. I should be very glad to have a copy of all the pamphlets or books you are editing about the situation of the Jews in the different countries. I hope in a short time to have a memorandum on Poland from a Jewish gentleman dwelling here. If I think that it shall be of any use for you, I shall send you a copy.
