My dear Professor Simonsen:

Prof. D. Simonsen, Copenhagen, Denmark.

I received and wish to thank you for your kind letter of the 26th of March. I had previously received your article on the situation with regard to the Jews in Lithuania which appeared in "Politiken" and I believe I have already acknowledged receipt of the same.

I note that you will not be able to do anything with regard to report on the Jews in Poland which you were so good as to inform us about. We expect to receive a report from Mr. Sokolow and if the same arrives in good time it will serve our purpose.

There recently appeared in Copenhagen snarticl of Dr. Georg Brandes stating his attitude toward the Jewish question. I should be thankful to you if you could forward us this article in the original. I have recently written to Dr. Brandes asking for a contribution to The Maccabasan Magazine, the Zionist publication with which I am identified, but I have so far received no reply. This magazine would be glad to pay a reasonable amount for any contributions from Dr. Brandes relating to Jewish questions and perhaps, if it is not too much trouble for you, you may have the opportunity of forwarding this message to him.
