Dear Sir:

The Jewish people in America are very desirous to do whatever may be in their power to promote the well-being of their co-religionists in the various countries now and when peace shall be brought about, but they are very loathe to take decisive steps without knowing the views of the leaders in your country and in other lands.

This organization is planning to confer with the representatives of other Jewish organizations in the United States, respecting the subject. It is contemplated to hold such a conference in October next, unless good reasons appear to make it inadvisable. The American Jewish Committee, therefore, respectfully requests that you be good enough to send as far in advance of that time as possible, such information, suggestions, and advice as you may deem helpful.
