Dear Colleague:

It will also interest you to know that the Commission on Jewish Education has at its last meeting decided to award a national diploma to those teachers who will pursue courses in a local normal school meeting the requirements prescribed in the minimum curriculum listed in the monograph on Teacher Training, Page 28-30.

Perhaps there is a possibility that you will organize a normal school or class this year. Perhaps you have organized one since we wrote to you last year. If so, please return the enclosed questionnaire at once indicating which syllabi you wish to order for your classes. Copies of each of the syllabi may be obtained at the rate of 50¢ for the entire set. One copy of the syllabus used by the students is sent free of charge to the Rabbi or principal conducting the normal school.
