Dear Professor Simonsen:

Louis Marshall, Esq; will be seventy years old on December 14, 1926. It is known to his friends that he is averse to any kind of demonstration, public or otherwise. On the other hand, there are a number of us who feel that Mr. Marshall's public services and his services to Judaism and to the Jewish people have been so great that the occasion should not be allowed to pass unnoticed. We are therefore planning to hand him an address of which the enclosed gives you an idea. This address will be beautifully engrossed and illuminated and handsomely bound, and we thought that you would wish to be a signer to such an address yourself and that you would want to get others in your community as well as in the principal communities throughout Denmark who know and appreciate Mr. Marshall's work to sign such a document with you. For this purpose we are enclosing herewith sheets of paper ruled in two columns to accommodate 26 names each on which we would ask you to have these signatures affixed and returned perfectly flat. Please be very careful of these. If at all possible we should like to have these in our hands no later than October 25, 1926, so we would ask you to take it up at once. For obvious reasons this matter should be handled as quietly as possible, so that the present-

ation of the address might come to Mr. Marshall as a complete surprise.

As we are anxious to expedite the gathering of these signatures I will appreciate it if you will advise me of any expenses of postage and other items that you may incur so that they may be refunded by our Committee.
