COPENHAGEN.

Your Excellency,

As you have been kind enough, at the request of Professor D. Simonsen here, to cable to the State Department in Washington regarding the remittance of relief funds in gold from Copenhagen for the benefit of the suffering Jewish population in Palestine, we beg to draw your attention to the following matter.

As far as we are knowing no answer has, as yet, arrived on that cablegram. The Danish National Bank, however, has received a message by cablegram that a part of the amount in question, viz.: \$ 19,000 have been payed in to the National City Bank in New-York on the account of the National Bank here.

As the last dreadful events in Palestine have made it urgently necessary to support the unhappy Jewish population there, the paying of the rest of the amount already granted, viz.: \$ 44,000 is highly desirable.

We therefore take the liberty of begging your Excellency to be kind enough to permit the enclosed cable to be sent through your Legation to the Department of State in Washington.

Thanking you most cordially for your high-minded kind attitude towards the grand Relief Work of the American Jews we beg to express in advance our sincere gratitude on occasion of this particular case and remain
