We have done our best to find a girl baby between 3 & 6 months old for your friend, but so far have not been successful.

The child, whom we thought to recommend, - a sweet girl of 7 months, whose mother had been killed in a motor accident & whose father is away & not known - cannot

be available, as the grandmothers
will not part from it.

If your friend will wait
a little while, we are sure
to hear of a baby that can
be adopted, and my friend
Mrs Model will keep a good
look out for such an infant.

When I tell you that we have
a Society here which assists
in bringing into the world
more than 1,000 little

Jewish babies a year, you
will say that it ought not
to be a hard task. But
happily the mother's love is
so powerful among our poor
folk, that in spite of care
& semi-starvation, every new born
child is welcome.
