Dear Mr. Lucas,

As we have had the honor and pleasure to see Dr. J. Goldman here, and as he has cabled to you (William Str.) it is not necessary for me to tell you many things on which I otherwise should have had to relate.

I therefore only acknowledge your telegram about the 60 tons flour. I have cabled to ^{Libau} Riga and Kowno to hear about the matter and shall then proceed, when I am instructed from the parts. The number of Jews in Lithuania is very much greater than in Letland.

For Mr. Brenner:

As Mrs. Bearman from Riga has the necessary ~~and~~ visa and the money for the voyage, I hope, that she shall soon be ^{leave} here and can then ~~go~~ for America

Dr. Cheifiz, Chief of the Red Cross, Ukraina parts to-morrow via England to Amerika. You will find in him a very instructed and goodhearted man, whom I wish all assistance for the great enterprise to the benefit of the Ukrainian children.
